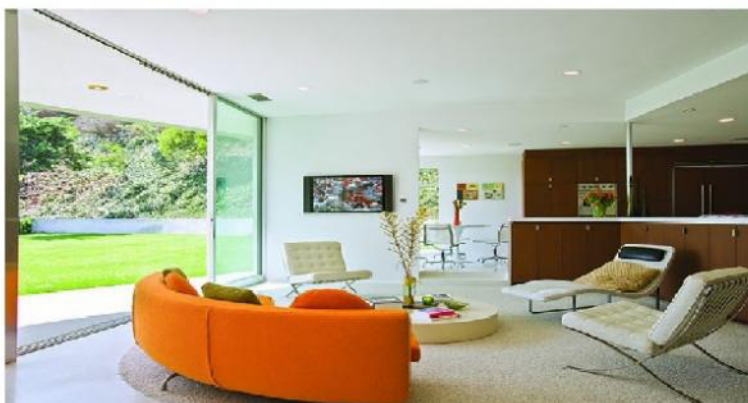

The units range from 3,271 sq. ft. to 4,496 sq. ft. Up to 40 percent of the units were sold during the launch in December 2017.
